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



## FINAL CONSOLIDATED WORKSHOP REPORT

### Basic Workshop in Health Sciences Education Technology

The Basic Workshop in Health Sciences Education Technology was conducted at KEMT's Virar Homoeopathic Medical College under the guidance of the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences (MUHS), Nashik, from 27 January 2026 to 29 January 2026.

The workshop was organized with the objective of strengthening faculty competencies in teaching-learning processes, curriculum planning, assessment strategies, and educational practices in health sciences. The programme comprised structured academic sessions, interactive discussions, and practical exercises, promoting active participation and collaborative learning among faculty members from various institutions.

#### DAY 1 – 27/01/2026

##### Session

Title: Pre-test and Ice-Breaking

Faculty: Dr. Bipin Jain

##### Summary:

The workshop commenced with a pre-test to assess the baseline knowledge of participants regarding health sciences education and teaching-learning methods. This was followed by ice-breaking activities aimed at creating a comfortable, interactive, and learner-friendly environment.

##### Remarks:

The session facilitated interaction among participants from different institutions and prepared them for active engagement throughout the workshop.

2) Session

Title: Phenomenon of Learning and Principles of Adult Learning

Faculty: Dr. Bipin Jain

Summary:

Fundamental concepts of learning, factors influencing learning, and principles of adult learning (andragogy) were discussed.

Remarks:

Interactive discussions and practical examples enabled participants to relate learning theories to real-life teaching situations.

3) Session

Title: Domains and Taxonomy

Faculty: Dr. Shama Rao

Summary:

The cognitive, affective, and psychomotor domains of learning were explained along with Bloom's taxonomy and its revised version.

Remarks:

Participants gained clarity on selecting appropriate action verbs while framing learning objectives.

4) Session

Title: Curriculum, Outcomes, and Objectives

Faculty: Dr. Shama Rao

Summary:

Outcome-based education, curriculum planning, and formulation of SMART learning objectives were discussed.

Remarks:

Examples from health sciences education illustrated alignment between curriculum, teaching strategies, and assessment methods.

5) Session

Title: Introduction to Teaching–Learning Methods

Faculty: Dr. Bhavik Parekh

Summary:

Various teaching–learning methods, including teacher-centered and learner-centered approaches, were introduced.

Remarks:

Emphasis was placed on selecting appropriate methods based on learning objectives and learner needs.

Title: Communication Skills

Faculty: Dr. Bhavik Parekh

Summary:

Principles of effective communication, verbal and non-verbal communication, and barriers to communication were discussed.

Remarks:

The importance of communication skills in teaching and professional practice was highlighted.

## Statistical Analysis and Interpretation of Pre-test and Post-test Scores

### Study Design

The present analysis is based on a pre-test and post-test evaluation conducted on the same group of 30 participants. Since measurements were taken before and after an intervention on identical subjects, the study follows a within-subject (paired) study design.

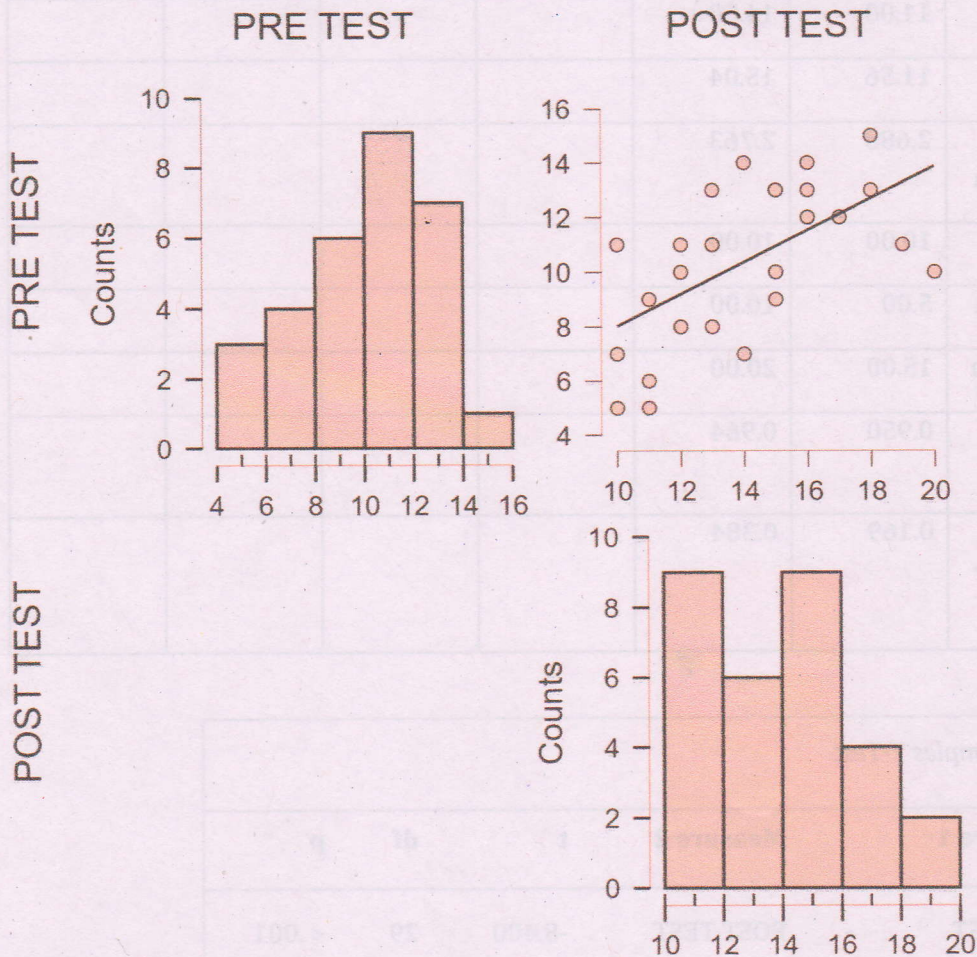

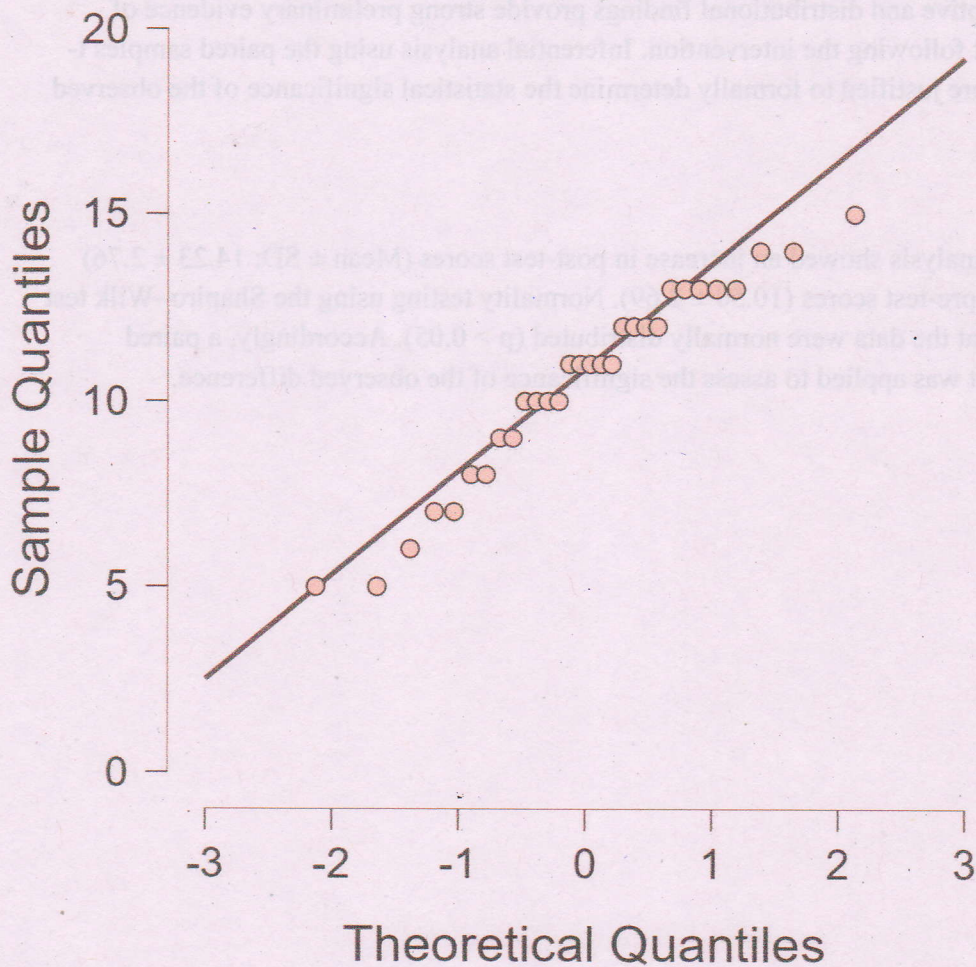

Descriptive statistics were computed to summarize the distribution of pre-test and post-test scores. All 30 cases were valid, with no missing data, indicating complete follow-up and reliable data collection.

The mean pre-test score was 10.50 with a standard deviation of 2.69, whereas the mean post-test score increased to 14.23 with a standard deviation of 2.76. The median values also showed an increase from 11.00 in the pre-test to 14.50 in the post-test. Similarly, the mode increased from 11.56 to 15.04. These findings demonstrate a consistent improvement in scores following the intervention.

The range of scores remained the same for both assessments (range = 10), with pre-test scores ranging from 5 to 15 and post-test scores ranging from 10 to 20. This indicates that improvement was observed across the entire group without an increase in score variability.





#### Assessment of Normality

The assumption of normality was assessed using the Shapiro–Wilk test. For the pre-test scores, the Shapiro–Wilk statistic was 0.950 with a p-value of 0.169. For the post-test scores, the Shapiro–Wilk statistic was 0.964 with a p-value of 0.384.

Since the p-values for both pre-test and post-test scores were greater than 0.05, there was no statistically significant deviation from normal distribution. Therefore, the data satisfy the normality assumption required for parametric testing.

#### Interpretation of Findings

The observed increase in mean, median, and mode values from pre-test to post-test indicates a clear positive shift in scores following the intervention. The consistency of standard deviation values suggests that the improvement was uniform across participants and not driven by extreme values.

These descriptive and distributional findings provide strong preliminary evidence of improvement following the intervention. Inferential analysis using the paired samples t-test is therefore justified to formally determine the statistical significance of the observed change.

### Result

Descriptive analysis showed an increase in post-test scores (Mean  $\pm$  SD:  $14.23 \pm 2.76$ ) compared to pre-test scores ( $10.50 \pm 2.69$ ). Normality testing using the Shapiro–Wilk test confirmed that the data were normally distributed ( $p > 0.05$ ). Accordingly, a paired samples t-test was applied to assess the significance of the observed difference.
